

Provincial Finals Entry

Updated Feb23, 2008

1. The AHSRA will use the same format and ranking system for qualifiers. Top 8 in each district (24) and top 20 in WD, as well as roll ups to fill open positions to the maximum of 24/20, if there is contestants available.
2. **Entries for high school finals will be Monday, June 2, 2008 from 2 PM to 8 PM at HS CES. Entries for WD finals will be Thursday, May 1 from 2 PM to 8 PM at WD CES.**
3. **Anyone who thinks they might be eligible (in the top 8/20 or expecting a roll up) please call in and enter.**
4. HS will determine the shooting team from national qualifiers. WD shooting competition contestants must enter at the same time as event entries.
5. After entries close, the top 24 positions for high school (top 8 from each district to a max. of 24 in each event, not including ties) and the top 20 positions for WD will be filled.
6. If a district does not have 8 contestants in an event, the position will be filled by ranking from the remaining districts that have more than 8 contestants in that event. (Contestants will be entered by ranking at the district level at end of the season)
7. All entries will be checked to ensure they have sold their tickets and are not on any ineligible lists.
8. All positions will be filled from the entries received on entry day.
9. **No calls will be made to fill positions.**
10. **The extra entries that do not qualify due to tickets, memberships or blacklists, or events being filled to the maximum (from season's ranking) will be drawn out.**
11. **The official list of provincial finals qualifiers will be posted on website within 2 days of entries being taken.**
12. **There will be no call back; the official list of provincial qualifiers will be on the website.**
13. **If you have entered and are not on the list of provincial qualifiers you have been drawn out.**
