New back numbers, membership cards and any other information will be given to you by your district secretary at the first rodeo you attend. It's going to be a very busy year for all districts and WD with lots of dates and deadlines to remember. Just a hint for entries, have a backup plan, find a buddy and both of you enter. The CES system works well and all the calls are recorded by the time of call in so we know by the
